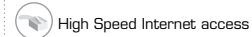


## 1. Check for Required Items

You should already have these components:



All of the following items should be included with your ACN Videophone.

If an item is missing, please contact ACN Digital Phone Service Technical Support.

Main Unit



Handset



Power Adapter  
(with country specific mains adapter, where applicable)



Ethernet Cable  
(RJ-45)



Telephone Cable  
(RJ-11)



### 2.A. Installation with Router (requires Router with free port)

1. Connect the handset to the connection point located on the side of your ACN Videophone.
2. Connect one end of the Ethernet cable (RJ-45) to the WAN port of your ACN Videophone. Connect the other end to an open Ethernet port on your router.
3. Ensure that your computer is connected to another port on your router or via an existing Wireless (WIFI) connection
4. Connect the Power Adapter to the Power port and then plug it into an electrical outlet.  
Note: Do not use Power Adapters from other devices.
5. Turn the Power Switch to ON on your ACN Videophone.
6. You will see a status line on your screen as your phone goes through setup. Once this is complete, the register light on the front of your phone will turn green, and it is ready for use.  
Note: Simultaneous use of the computer and the Videophone will affect the quality of the connection.

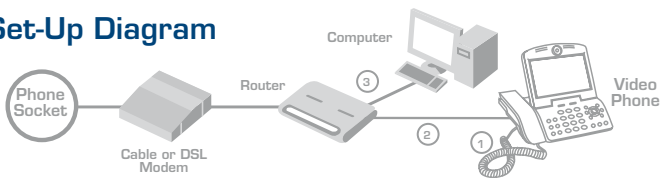
If you do not have a computer simply connect your ACN Videophone to your modem or router as described in step 2.

### 2.B. Installation without Router

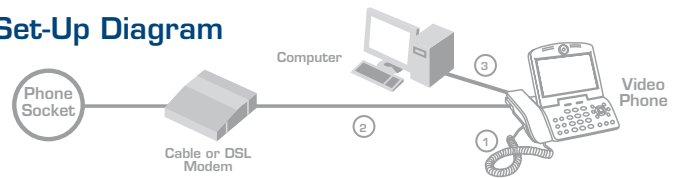
1. Connect the handset to the connection point located on the side of your ACN Videophone.
2. Unplug the existing Ethernet cable from your computer that connects your Cable/DSL modem to your computer. The other end of this cable should stay attached to your modem. Connect the Ethernet cable that you unplugged from your computer to the WAN port of your ACN Videophone.
3. Connect one end of the new Ethernet cable (RJ-45) that came with your Videophone, to the LAN port of the phone. Connect the other end to the Ethernet port of your computer.
4. Connect the power adapter to the power port and then plug it into an electrical outlet.  
Note: Do not use Power Adapters from other devices.
5. Turn the Power Switch to ON on your ACN Videophone.
6. You will see a status line on your screen as your phone goes through setup. Once this is complete, the register light on the front of your phone will turn green, and it is ready for use.  
Note: Simultaneous use of the computer and the Videophone will affect the quality of the connection.

If you do not have a computer simply connect your ACN Videophone to your modem or router as described in step 2.

## Changing the Display Language

1. Press MENU and select 'Settings'.



2. Select 'System Settings'.



3. Select 'Display' and scroll down to 'Language'.



4. Select one of the language options.

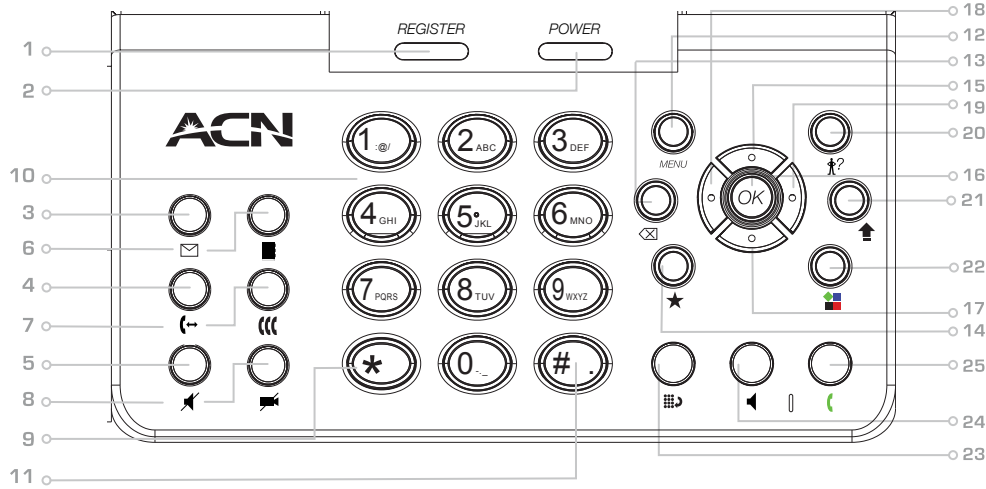
## 3. Optional: Connecting existing/additional phone(s) to your ACN Videophone



#### Connecting additional phones to your ACN Videophone

Connect one end of a phone cord to the phone port on your ACN Videophone. The other end of the cord can connect to another phone. If you connect to a cordless phone you can use your ACN Digital Phone Service anywhere in your home.

**Front**



<b>1 Register</b>	The green LED light is on when your Videophone is connected to ACN's Digital Phone Service.	<b>14 My Content</b>	Lists available content.
<b>2 Power</b>	Indicates if your Videophone is switched on.	<b>15 Up</b>	Up navigation button.
<b>3 Mail</b>	Allows you to retrieve video/voicemail.	<b>16 OK</b>	Use to enter selections and save settings in the "Settings" menu.
<b>4 Hold</b>	Enables you to place calls on hold.	<b>17 Down</b>	Down navigation button.
<b>5 Mute</b>	Disables the voice transmission during the call.	<b>18 Left Navigation</b>	Left navigation button.
<b>6 Phonebook</b>	Provides access to your personal phonebook.	<b>19 Right Navigation</b>	Right navigation button.
<b>7 Conference</b>	Allows you to audio conference multiple callers on to one call (3-Way Calling).	<b>20 Status</b>	Lists information needed for technical support i.e. configuration and software version
<b>8 Privacy</b>	Temporarily disables the video signal transmission during a call.	<b>21 Caps</b>	Allows you to enter capital letters and selects the type of letters or characters to enter. Switches between numeric, lower-case letters and upper-case letters.
<b>9 *</b>	Enters "*"	<b>22 My Applications</b>	Lists available applications.
<b>10 Numeric Keypad</b>	Enters phone number in the dialling mode or letters in the "Settings" menu.	<b>23 Redial</b>	Makes a call to the last number dialled.
<b>11 #</b>	Enters "#". Rejects the incoming call.	<b>24 Speaker</b>	Activates/deactivates the speakerphone.
<b>12 Menu</b>	Activates the "Main" menu on your LCD screen.	<b>25 Call</b>	Makes a call to the dialled number.
<b>13 Back</b>	Moves to the previous menu from the "Settings" menu or "Set Up" menu during a call and deletes characters when entering information.		

**Making a Call**

Making a call with the Videophone is simple. Whether you are making a voice or video call, pick up the handset, dial the number and press the 'Call' button. To keep your image from being displayed to the other party when making a video call press the 'Privacy' button.

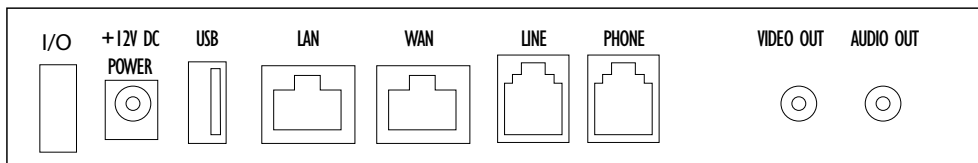
**Voicemail Set-up & Access**

- Press the 'Mail' button. The first time you access your mailbox enter 1234, after which you can define your 4-digit access code. Follow the voice prompts to set-up your mailbox.
- To retrieve your message(s) press '1' after accessing your mailbox.

**Rear**



<b>I/O (On/off)</b>	Turns your videophone on/off
<b>+12V DC Power</b>	Connects to the power adapter
<b>USB</b>	USB port used to transfer data to/from your Videophone
<b>Lan</b>	Local Area Network connection
<b>Wan</b>	Connects to Internet via the Ethernet cable
<b>Phone</b>	Connects a cordless or corded phone to your Videophone
<b>Video out</b>	Transmits video to a TV or Computer
<b>Audio out</b>	Transmits audio to external speakers or audio system
